



- Nails to be cut short.






### Assessment Pattern - CISCE

### Promotion Policy



#### • **Grades 1 to 3:**

All students are promoted based on continual assessments. Regular monitoring will be done in the classes by way of worksheets and assignments. A continuous evaluation procedure is implemented throughout the year.

#### Grades 4 and upwards:

Only students who have appeared for all tests and Examinations and who have passed in all subjects will be eligible for promotion.

A minimum of 40% marks in each subject and in aggregate in each term is required to qualify for promotion to next class.

Internal assessment marks are counted for final aggregate.



### Student Admission Process

DPSIS started its operation in Singapore on 19th April 2004. At school, our earnest desire is to nurture the young fertile minds by positive development through excellent academic and extra curricular inputs.

The school ensures that students coming from diverse communities, regions, backgrounds and professions are given a common platform and equal opportunities. Students of all nationalities are welcome to take admission in the school. Singapore citizens, however, will be required to seek approval from the Ministry of Education.

The school follows:

- 1) CISCE curriculum- Academic Year April to March
- 2) CAIE curriculum Academic Year (Grade 9 -12) Jan to Dec
- ( Grade 8 IGCSE April Dec)

Currently, the school has classes from Pre-Nursery, Nursery and Kindergarten to Grade 12.

We encourage you to make an appointment with the admin office before you visit the school for admission.



### **Admission Process**

- **Step 1**: Fill in the Online Enquiry Form or approach school.
- **Step 2**: School Admission department will contact the aspirant parent within two working days.
- Step 3: Admission counsellor will explain the enrolment process
- **Step 4**: Followed by assessment test (if required), subsequent procedure will be communicated.
- **Step 5**: A formal interaction with the Vice Principal/Principal.
- **Step 6**: Admission to the school will be subject to:
  - Age Criteria
  - > Result of the Assessment Test.
  - Previous Grade Academic result.
- **Step 7**: On confirmation for admission, all applications are to be accompanied by an application processing fee (link), this is non-refundable. This fee will, however, be adjusted towards Registration fee, Tuition fee & other components.
- **Step 8**: Subsequently Advisory Note and student contract will be formalized.



### Course Transfer Policy



#### COURSE TRANSFER POLICY:

#### **Transfer Policy**

Course Transfer refers to a student request for a transfer to another course within DPS INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL.

- 2. Transfers will have to be approved by the Academic Board based on the academic demands of the new Course, the students' prevailing performance levels and suitability and residual months available after transfer.
- 3. Transfer between courses shall be approved and effected within first two months of the new course commencement date.
- Transfer to another School (in or outside the country) is not allowed as the school has only one operational campus in Singapore.
   (Transfer of Course within the School is allowed)

#### **Transfer Procedure**

- Students (or parents) seeking transfer shall make a written application for consideration by the school, stating the reasons for transfer.
- 2. The Academic Department including the relevant subject teachers shall evaluate the request based on the academic performance of the student, emotional and social suitability to the student.

DPS will provide pre-course counselling for the intended course.

- The Principals/Head of Schools shall approve any transfer.
- 5. The transfer decision shall be communicated to the student/parent.
- 6. All transfer requests will be responded to within 7 working days from receipt of written transfer request
- 7. On acceptance by the parent/student, a revised contract shall be executed with the student along with the applicable fees for the new course.

#### Change of Course will allow students to transfer from one course to another within DPS in the same academic year:

#### Case 1: Change from CISCE to CAIE Curriculum (or vice versa)

(Applicable for students Grade 8 and above)

Students who have already registered with CISCE course (vice versa) are eligible to change to CAIE. Students who meet the necessary criteria may request transfer between the courses i.e., Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE) and IGCSE.

In the event of a change of course as mentioned above, a new Student Contract shall be executed between DPS and the Student to reflect the change of course and old student contract should be terminated.

#### Case 2: Change from one course to another within the same curriculum

(Applicable to all students of any Grade)

Students are allowed to cheat the course within the same academic year (e.g. from Grade 2 to Grade 3) based on teacher/Principal recommendations or parent request.
